

Dry Fly and Trout Fly Accuracy

Models TF 1027 and TF 1026

Both models are medium taper action and medium soft in stiffness. This overall light power design helps promote a smooth lay down and presentation to the target. Dry Fly model TF 1027 balances with a DT 7 floating line and for Trout Fly TF 1026 balances with a DT 6. Some casters who like stiffer rods for trout fly may use the Dry Fly model with a DT 6 for extra overall power. There is no special rod configuration for tournament application.

GUIDE PLACEMENT FROM TIP:

Tip, 4, 9, 15, 22, 29 1/2, 37 1/4, 45 3/8, 54 1/4, 63 1/4, 72 3/4.

GUIDE SIZE FROM TIP:

Small fly tip, four #3 single foot snake guides, three #4 single foot snake guides, one each; 10 and 12 stripper guides.

HANDLE CONFIGURATION:

Half or full-wells handle with down-lock reel-seat.
